

Frequently asked questions about fire debris and trash service

Q: I have trash service questions, who do I call?

A: Please call CR & R Disposal, 760-868-6353.

Q: Will the transfer station take fire debris?

A: No. Transfer stations are not permitted to take fire debris.

Q: Can I take my fire debris to the landfill?

A: Fire debris from homes built post-1985 will not require asbestos inspection and therefore can be taken directly to the landfill.

Q: What if the home was built pre-1985, what do I need to do?

A: Debris from structures built prior to 1985 will be subject to asbestos inspection performed by a Cal/OSHA Certified Asbestos Consultant. If the inspection finds asbestos, the asbestos will have to be removed by a Cal/OSHA Registered Asbestos Removal Contractor. Once the debris has been cleared of asbestos and before taking it to the landfill, call the Solid Waste Management Division to obtain a clearance letter. Q: Which landfills take fire debris?

A: These sites take fire debris:

- Mid-Valley Landfill, 2390 N. Alder Avenue, Rialto, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday
- San Timoteo Landfill, 31 Refuse Road, Redlands, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday thru Saturday
- Victorville Landfill, 18600 Stoddard Wells Road, Victorville, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday thru Saturday
- Barstow Landfill, 32553 Barstow Road, Barstow, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Saturday

Q: Can I use my Disposal Use Permit for fire debris?

A: No. The Permit is for regular household waste. You can use it for spoiled food and burned vegetation.

Q: Do loads have to be covered?

A: Yes. Uncovered loads are charged double at the landfill.

Q: Can I use another trash hauler besides CR & R to haul my fire debris?

A: No. CR & R is the exclusive hauler for your area.
