In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

Flow Activity Continuation	Angela Myles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The HPN attendees broke off into five groups to work together on topics of interest in San Bernardino County. The groups were each given 30 minutes to brainstorm, prioritize, and discuss before bringing their ideas back to the HPN as a whole. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Homeless Prevention group discussed a lack of community knowledge and involvement regarding homeless issues. They also expressed a need for a client centered approach with a centralized intake and a collaborative one-stop shop. This group expressed a need for funding in this area. ○ The Housing group decided that the greatest need in San Bernardino County is permanent housing. They discussed needing funding and grants, and where to go to apply. In addition, this group discussed income and the benefits of a 5 year lease. ○ The Basic Needs group discussed the need for information flow. They wish to start with outreach workers who know where to find resources and then will connect individuals to those resources. Identification is also needed along with shelter and benefits. ○ The Discharge Planning group discussed the need for funding and an increase in services as well as providers. They thought it would be a good idea to have a liaison at each facility where individuals are discharged. ○ The Employment group spoke of a certification process for employability. They would need case management, email and information access, as well as transportation. • The goal of the flow activity was to bring information on the priorities for San Bernardino County providers to the HPN Steering Committee so that each subcommittee can work and move forward with the goals of the 10-Year Strategy to End Homelessness. • Discussion for the floor activity will be continued to next month's HPN.
