

Clients who attend the monthly meeting will have the opportunity to enroll in a 3-day workshop sponsored by the County of San Bernardino Department of Workforce Development. Clients will learn critical skills needed to obtain employment in the ever-changing workplace. The workshop assists clients with addressing a felony conviction during the application and interview process as well as how to effectively address gaps in employment. Many graduates from the workshop are now successfully employed.
