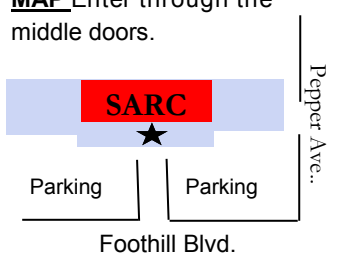

## ***How does the SARC process work?***

When you come into the SARC, you will meet with a staff member who will conduct a confidential assessment for substance use treatment placement.

Once you have been assessed, our staff member will discuss what the best treatment options are for you. Once you both agree on your treatment, our staff member will help coordinate appointments and other necessary arrangements at one of our treatment provider agencies.

- Residential
- Adult Outpatient Drug Free
- Adolescent Outpatient Drug Free

- Perinatal (Services for pregnant and parenting women with children through the age of 10 years)
- Recovery Centers
