

5150/5585 Transportation Policy

Policy It is the policy of the Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) to arrange transportation to a Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Act designated facility for a person placed under 5150 or 5585 by a DBH staff person for evaluation.

Purpose To establish guidelines for the transportation of persons who, as the result of a mental disorder are exhibiting the following behaviors or a combination of these behaviors:

- A danger to self or others
- Gravely disabled
- Gravely disabled minors
