Course Description: The release of the DSM-5 has brought with it many changes to diagnosis and how treatment needs are identified and measured. This training is designed to assist diagnosticians in understanding the primary changes and how it will impact daily practice. Participants will be introduced to new diagnoses, reorganization of diagnostic categories and clinical utility of the manual.

Objectives:

1. Identify key changes in the structure of the DSM from DSM-IV to DSM 5.
2. Identify ways in which the DSM has changed to accommodate integration with ICD.
3. Identify changes in diagnoses commonly seen in public mental health settings.
4. Explore new diagnoses in the DSM-5 and the impact on current service provision.

- Registration begins ½ hour prior to start and doors close promptly at the start of training.
