- To identify legal issues and liabilities
- To perform proper vehicle maintenance and inspection procedures
- To use safe driving techniques for adverse driving conditions
- To use techniques for code 3 operations
- To use and control various types of braking methods
- To avoid the most common causes of emergency vehicle collisions
- To avoid and/or control physiological and psychological factors affecting emergency vehicle operators
- Precision vehicle placement at slow and high speeds, and in reverse using a spotter
- Emergency hazard avoidance techniques
