



## Industry Guidance for Pumpkin Patches

- The State currently allows outdoor retail sales in San Bernardino County, pumpkin patches as outdoor retail sales locations may operate under the State retail guidance, <https://files.covid19.ca.gov/pdf/guidance-retail--en.pdf>.
- The State does not currently allow amusement park rides of any kind or other high-touch/close contact attractions, including animal rides, petting zoos, slides, bounce houses, and ball pits.
- The County Department of Public Health will not permit the operation of Temporary Food Facilities. Mobile food facilities with permits could be considered as an option. These would include food trucks, catering, sidewalk vending, and farmers' markets certified by the County Agricultural Commissioner.
- Dining areas must be established outdoors and follow State guidance, <https://files.covid19.ca.gov/pdf/guidance-outdoor-restaurants--en.pdf>.
- Outdoor games, mazes, and other activities will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by the County Environmental Health Services Division.
- Municipalities have the ability to implement stricter standards. Pumpkin patch operators are urged to consult with the County Department of Public Health by calling 909-387-3911 **before opening** to ensure their plans are in compliance with State Health Orders. The County **will enforce** State Health Orders within the County's jurisdiction.
