The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

There is one significant change under Article IX, Committees, the Discharge Planning Committee has been added as a standing Committee. Therefore, the standing committees have been increased from five to six. Joann Claytor is the Chair of the Discharge Planning Committee. The Discharge Planning Committee was put together in response to the Continuum of Care (CoC) Homeless Assistance Grant Application that we submit for on a yearly basis. We have to address in terms of when an individual exits from corrections, foster care, a mental health facility, or a hospital. The Chair along with the Committee members coordinates with agencies to make them aware of the resources we have. They are making sure that organizations that are discharging individuals are aware of what resources they can connect them with. 17 of 20 voting members in attendance are in favor of item. Motion has passed and amended by-laws are approved.
