In September 2007, the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership (SBCHP) was formed to provide a more focused approach to our goal of ending homelessness within the County. The Partnership consists of city governments, community based organizations, faith-based organizations, educational institutes, non-profit organizations, private industry, and federal, state, and local government.

SBCHP was developed to promote a strong collaboration between agencies to direct the planning, development, and implementation of the County's 10-year-plan to end chronic homelessness. The Partnership meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the Behavioral Health Resource Center in Rialto. The Partnership facilitates better communication, planning, coordination, and cooperation among all entities that provide services and/or resources for the relief of homelessness in San Bernardino County.

Mission Statement

The Mission of the San Bernardino County Homeless Partnership is to provide a system of care that is inclusive, well planned, coordinated and evaluated and is accessible to all who are homeless and those at-risk of becoming homeless.

Open Discussion	Kent Paxton Luis Castellanos Gary Madden / Don Smith	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There was discussion about the National Alliance to End Homelessness Conference in Washington DC and a follow up call with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on how to better use Medicaid resources more effectively and about how each subpopulation (veterans, homeless youth, family with children) are unique. • Vet centers work with veterans to get service connected. Contact number for Luis is 909-801-5762. • The Coordinated Entry System (CES) Pilot was discussed. CoC's must commit to have a central starting place to connect people with resources in real time. It is a mandate and will take everyone in collaboration. • A suggestion was made to have a presentation from Lighthouse and Knowledge and Education for your Success (KEYS) for a future meeting. • There was discussion about the need for information sharing through the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). A suggestion was made to ask the Homeless Provider Network (HPN) Chair to ask county council what would be technically and legally possible in terms of collaborating in ClientTrack.

Homeless Veteran Community Planning Group	Karyn Young-Lowe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As part of the Presidents mandate to end veteran's homelessness, additional funding was made available through Supportive Services for Veterans and Families (SSVF) along with additional HUD- Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (VASH) program vouchers. • A planning group was created to bring all members of the continuum together to determine how we could

		<p>end veterans' homelessness. A master list was created identifying all homeless veterans in San Bernardino and Riverside County. Both continuums have come together to identify and link those veterans with providers who get them into permanent housing. The group meets in person twice a month and have conference calls on alternate weeks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A takedown number was identified through the VA's gap analysis. The gap analysis used the point in time count along with a multiplier used nationally to come up with the number of veterans needing to be served. For San Bernardino County, the number is 401 and for Riverside it is 382. Since January 2015, 140 homeless veterans have been housed in San Bernardino County. An additional 261 will need to be housed between now and the end of year. There are 91 homeless veterans identified on the master list still searching and more are being added each week. If you are working with any homeless veterans or if you have currently housed them we would like to get them on our list. For San Bernardino please send the names to Lily Palacios and for Riverside you can send to Anabel Ramos. A release of information will need to be signed for all those names on the list. We need to work together to reach functional zero so we do not lose our funding in this county. • For additional information or if you would like to join the meetings let Lily Palacios from KEYS or Anabel Ramos of the County of Riverside know. • The Board of Supervisors had a special study session last month and made a commitment to end veterans' homelessness by bringing Phil Mangano in to work with us to meet that goal. An advisory committee was also set up to identify barriers to get veterans and their families off the street. • There are housing navigators assisting with application fees, security deposits, move in costs, rental assistance. Landlord fairs are being held to educate landlords and connect them with veterans.
