A second was made by Mike Jones. All were in favor, none opposed. The motion was carried. The consent calendar was approved.

D. ICH Special Meeting Update E. Update on timeline for HHAP Funding Priorities	Don Smith	 Bessine Richard was unavailable. Jessica Alexander asked Don Smith to provide a recap of the latest special ICH meeting from last Thursday, March 26, 2020. Don reported that 3 items were discussed by from the CoC in response to the COVID 19 emergency. ICH accepted money from the state and appointed the CEO and AEO of the county to implement and direct funding of around \$508,000 to the COVID emergency response. CEO and AEO to utilize unspent CESH funding and allocating roughly around \$2 million dollars to put on the ground immediately towards the COVID 19 efforts. Authorize CEO and AEO the opportunity to review and process compliance of HEAP spending from HEAP project providers. To consider reallocation of non-compliance and of unspent funds and redirect those unspent funds towards the COVID-19 emergency response. Letter will be coming out from OHS explaining the HEAP process. No money will be snatched, and this will be used to look at the next steps/phrase of HEAP CaSonya Thomas has been designated as the point of person on this effort. HHAP updates: Co-chairs met with OHS and due to the recent COVID emergency HHAP has been pushed back. Providers can still email Jessica Alexander on any issues or concerns regarding HHAP.

F. Discuss COVID-19 Response and Future Outcomes	CaSonya Thomas 1:30-2 pm	 From Don Smith – initial roll out of donated 50 vouchers have been established and 20 trailers have been secured. Location – unknown at this moment? Working on multiple strategies while dealing with limited capacity Isolation assistance for COVID negative but high risk Negative COVID with low risk are given guidance on prevention Isolation for COVID positive or symptomatic individuals		

		 When asked who gets hotel/motel funding and how, CaSonya said that the hotels/motel will get those funds directly. She mentioned that the CoC and County have received \$975K for COVID-19 emergency funding. CaSonya mentioned that a task force committee will be established and will help strategize and offer recommendations. CaSonya suggested that some cities are already providing their own funding. There is no strategy right now for funding individual providers. That isolation is their key focus and motel isolation can last from 14 to 90 days and this will be a case by case situation. She suggested that HEAP funding adjustments will be considered for help with COVID and that an explanation of changes needs to be submitted to the office of homeless services. PPE concerns: a supply request has been submitted through the county's emergency (response) but those items are being allocated to healthcare, i.e. hospitals, EMS, police and fire. Someone asked about our agencies being considered as essential for needing those items, unfortunately, the PPE is being directed to those providers providing constant COVID aid. Access to large quantities soon is very low and full kits are unlikely.
