Review of recent county developments	Wendell Wilson, Co- Chair	<ul> <li>COVID</li> <li>Governor Newsom - \$500mm just housing vulnerable homeless</li> <li>Review of protocols</li> <li>March 26 – ICH - \$500k plus 1.6 mm from CESH – give county CEO authority to disburse those funds. <ul> <li>March 30, at a teleconference, county said they have a project in mind already. 50 units in motel in San Bernardino, over 65 and/or medically fragile, and already tested for COVID-19. HOPE team to manager</li> </ul> </li> <li>April 2 <ul> <li>County looking into renting other motels. Crestline and Victorille were mentioned. But no written plan yet presented.</li> </ul> </li> <li>What will be our response? <ul> <li>Mountain Homeless Coalition has been looking at a camp in Crestline, a camp in Big Bear, and a motel in Twin Peaks.</li> <li>County will set out many of the protocols and details.</li> <li>CaSonya Thomas is county lead. Jeré Thrasher from KEYS representing the nonprofits.</li> <li>We will probably need to fund about 6 months of efforts.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
BOARD COMMENT		
	Paul Fournier – Mountain Homeless Coalition	<ul> <li>Large uptick in calls from people concerned about potential eviction due to impaired income due to COVID. Expect the situation to get worse.</li> <li>Housing about 9 household units in hotels.</li> <li>Initial order from county did not make a provision to allow hotels to house the homeless. A March 27 revision from the Count Public Health Officer remedied that omission. Hotels and AirBnBs generally prohibited from taking in new guests, other than essential personnel.</li> <li>As a mountain community or communities, where will we be putting homeless individuals affected by COVID-19.</li> <li>State issued a flowchart on how to prioritize COVID cases <ul> <li>We need to understand the issues, and how to take care of it</li> <li>Mountains more likely to be hit by the economic effects of COVID than the healthcare effects of it.</li> <li>There is a DELAY on evictions by order (approx March 17-19) from the Governor's office, but no relief from ultimate responsibility to pay rent, and everything must be done in writing. No real protections, but some legal opinions</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
