

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be under 21 years of age
2. Must be a full-scope medical recipient
3. Must be receiving Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS)

Must meet one of the following four:

1. Placement in an RCL 12 or 14 residential facility
2. Consideration for placement in an RCL 12 or 14 residential facility by the county
3. Emergency psychiatric hospitalization in the preceding 24 months
4. Previously a TBS recipient
