Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Must be under 21 years of age
- 2. Must be a full-scope medical recipient
- 3. Must be receiving Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS)

Must meet one of the following four:

- 1. Placement in an RCL 12 or 14 residential facility
- 2. Consideration for placement in an RCL 12 or 14 residential facility by the county
- 3. Emergency psychiatric hospitalization in the preceding 24 months
- 4. Previously a TBS recipient
