The first TAY Center opened its doors in 2007, in the City of San Bernardino, to provide integrated services to unserved, underserved and inappropriately served youth ages 16 to 25 with mental health issues.

The One Stop TAY Center has been specially designed for youth, by youth and provides a safe place where youth can work on improving their quality of life.

Today, One Stop TAY Centers are located throughout San Bernardino County to provide transitional age youth access to mental health services countywide.
