COURSE DESCRIPTION

Objective Arts (OA) is the web-based data system used by the San Bernardino County Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) to provide structure to the utilization of Transformational Collaborative Outcomes Management (TCOM) tools (e.g., CANS, ANSA, & PSC-35) as required by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS).

Basic Training:

Basic Training is a hands-on course. It is intended to provide staff with the knowledge needed to utilize the OA system in the field.
