Our service areas are located in the East Valley of San Bernardino County (Redlands, Mentone, Loma Linda, Yucaipa, Highland, Grand Terrace and local mountain communities).

Housing and Service Orientations are hosted monthly to determine eligibility. Please call the office for more information.

Family

- **Surplus Food** Provided on a daily walk-in basis
- **Emergency Food Assistance** – Seven days' worth of groceries that covers 3 meals a day.
- **Clothing** – Provided to low income individuals for basic wear and employment
- **Hygiene Kits** – Includes soap, lotion and toothpaste
- **Employment Support** – Provides unemployed and under-employed clients with job resources.
- **Resource and Referrals**- Health, Dental and Vision referrals.
- **Childcare**- On site childcare, while clients attend classes or attend in-take sessions.
- **Homework Help**- Homework help for children kindergarten through eighth grade.
- **Holiday Support**- Food boxes for Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Adopt A Family for Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- **Holiday Activities**- Spring Fling, Mother's Day Tea, Costume Giveaway, Harvest Festival, Christmas Party and more!

Housing

- **Motel Vouchers** - Provides an emergency place to stay in a crisis situation when shelters are inaccessible.
- **Rental Assistance** – Provides emergency assistance for families facing eviction or who are already homeless with the goal of preventing the dangers of homelessness. *As funding permits.*

Educational Programs

- **Basic Life Skills Classes**
- **ESL**- English as a Second Language classes
- **Leadership Classes** – Teaches empowerment skills such as developing the leader in you, effective communication and goal-setting.
- **Money Management Classes**
- **Mommy and Me Classes**
- **Computer Lab**
- **Counseling** – In a partnership, Christian Counseling Services works with FSA to guide clients through the process of mental health counseling.
