



# Organized Camp Food Workers

Organizations that operate at camps longer than 2 weeks (14 days) and provide their own kitchen staff, are required to have their food workers complete the online [Food Handler Training](#) to obtain the San Bernardino County certified food handler's card.

Organizations that operate at camps 2 weeks or less and provide their own kitchen staff are **not** required to have their food workers obtain a food worker card. However, food workers are highly encouraged to complete the [Organized Camps Food Safety Training Course](#) online to receive a food safety certificate. The certificate is valid for up to two weeks.
