Senate Bill 1192 CHILDREN'S MEAL BEVERAGE

Effective January 1, 2019

Restaurants that sell children's meals must update default beverage options.

What is a restaurant?

A retail food establishment that prepares, serves, or vends food directly to the customer.

What is a children's meal?

A combination of food items and a beverage, or a single food item and a beverage, sold together at a single price, primarily intended for consumption by a child.

Restaurants must make the default beverage offered with children's meals one of the following:

- Water, sparkling water, or flavored water with no added natural or artificial sweeteners
- Unflavored milk
- Nondairy milk alternative

Can a restaurant sell an alternative beverage to children?

Yes. A restaurant can sell, or a customer can purchase, an alternative beverage instead of the default beverage offered with the children's meal, if requested by the purchaser of the children's meal.
