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Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Joint Technical Document (JTD) for the Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill is located at 2390 N. Alder Ave., Rialto, CA 92377. On January 28, 2020, the LEA received, from the operator of Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the Joint Technical Document (JTD).

The changes include the following:

- Updates to Figure 3A-Surrounding Land Uses and Zoning
- Updates to Figure 3B-Nearest Structure Map
- Updated legal description of the landfill property

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the amendment on March 4, 2020.
