Animal Care and Control announces new fee schedule

San Bernardino County's Animal Care and Control (ACC) is announcing the new licensing fee schedule for the next fiscal year that begins Wednesday, July 1, 2020. These fees apply to residents of all unincorporated county areas and the cities of Highland, Yucaipa and Big Bear Lake.

Dog licensing fees have increased, though discounts still exist for dogs that are altered (spayed or neutered) and for senior citizens and disabled citizens *with* altered dogs. Proof of spay/neuter certificate, senior citizen status, and disability are required to receive discounts. Additionally, there are discounts for purchasing a multi-year license.

The last time that fees were raised was in 2016.

ACC recommends all dogs be spayed or neutered to receive discounted licenses and to help control the homeless animal population. **Spaying/Neutering is mandatory in the unincorporated county areas and in the cities of Highland and Yucaipa for pit bull and pit bull-type dogs.** Financial assistance for spaying and neutering dogs and cats may be available by calling the Pet Over-Population Coalition (POPCO) at (888) 767-2550 for more information or visit www.popco-inc.org.

Disabled Citizen – Dog is spayed or neutered and owner is permanently disabled. (Spay/Neuter Certificate and proof of owner’s permanent disability required). \$1.50 per month	\$18.00	\$36.00	\$54.00
Medically Determined – Animal is at high risk for spay/neuter surgery and owner presents written documentation from a licensed veterinarian. \$2.50 per month	\$30.00	\$60.00	\$90.00
Regular – Dog is not spayed or neutered. \$10.00 per month	\$120.00	\$240.00	\$360.00

New owner with currently licensed dog – \$5.00

Replacement Dog Tag – \$5.00

Registration of dog currently licensed in another jurisdiction – \$5.00
