PRESENTATIONS





ANGER MANAGEMENT

This program is designed to teach youth personal skills to deal responsibly with stress and frustration. It also demonstrates to them the need to acknowledge the consequences of their behavior. It focuses on cause and effect and teaches youth to recognize their personal warning signals when emotions begin to get out of hand. In this skill-based program, individuals learn what they must do to avoid confrontational situations and how to manage their emotions and develop alternative behavioral responses.

DRUG & ALCOHOL

The program focuses on the area of self-esteem, interpersonal relationships, work ethic, self-direction and alternatives. This program explores patterns of use and contributing attitudes. MATRIX

SHOPLIFTING

This program focuses on the reasons a person shoplifts, and how to behave differently when faced with a similar situation. The program shows how attitudes can override a person's sense of right and wrong and cause behavior that is contrary to his or her beliefs. Participants regain the self-confidence they lost by committing the offense, and strengthen their ability to act in accordance with what they believe. **This is a 1-day, 2-hour class with a \$25.00 fee. TRUANCY
