## 24-Hour Driver Training Update

**Length:** 24 hours divided into three 8-hour days

**Tuition:** \$575 per student  
(Payable to San Bernardino County Sheriff's Dept.)

**Certification:** Certified by P.O.S.T.

T.R.R. forms must be submitted on the first day – POST Plan II

**Prerequisite:** Must be affiliated with a Law Enforcement Agency

**Overview:** Students will learn:

- To identify, avoid, and recover from various types of skids
- To identify and practice defensive driving techniques
- To identify and use vehicle dynamics to their advantage
- To identify legal issues and liabilities
- To perform proper vehicle maintenance and inspection procedures
- To use safe driving techniques for adverse driving conditions
- To use safe techniques for code 3 and pursuit operations
- To use and control various types of Law Enforcement collisions
- To avoid and/or control physiological and psychological factors
- Precision vehicle placement at slow and high speeds, and in reverse
- Emergency hazard avoidance techniques
