WRIT OF EXECUTION OR SALE. Your rights and duties are indicated on the accompanying *Notice of Levy* (form EJ-150).

WRIT OF POSSESSION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY. If the levying officer is not able to take custody of the property, the levying officer will demand that you turn over the property. If custody is not obtained following demand, the judgment may be enforced as a money judgment for the value of the property specified in the judgment or in a supplemental order.

WRIT OF POSSESSION OF REAL PROPERTY. If the premises are not vacated within five days after the date of service on the occupant or, if service is by posting, within five days after service on you, the levying officer will remove the occupants from the real property and place the judgment creditor in possession of the property. THE REDEMPTION PERIOD WILL DEPEND ON THE SELLING PRICE AS FOLLOWS: (709.030 CCP)

- A. **THREE MONTHS** AFTER THE DATE OF SALE IF THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE ARE SUFFICIENT TO SATISFY THE SECURED INDEBTEDNESS WITH INTEREST AND COSTS.
- B. **ONE YEAR** AFTER THE DATE OF SALE IF THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE ARE NOT SUFFICIENT TO SATISFY THE SECURED INDEBTEDNESS WITH INTEREST AND COSTS.
