## **Range Safety Rules**

- 1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
- 2. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire. (Master Grip)
- 3. Never point your muzzle at anything you don't intend to shoot, kill, destroy, or pay for.
- 4. Be aware of your backdrop and beyond.

Anyone can call for a cease fire if they see anything unsafe. If you are shooting and have a malfunction, keep your weapon pointed at your target, work through your issue, then continue firing. Do not raise your hand and ask an instructor to fix your firearm. You need to know how to clear any malfunctions you may encounter. There is wildlife out on the range, so if you see any on the range or beyond the targets please let an instructor know immediately. The first aid bags are located under the flag pole and next to the knock down phone. The knock down phone is located under the canopy and goes directly to Sheriff's Dispatch. In the event someone gets shot or suffers a major injury let an instructor know so we can contact dispatch. If we ask you to use the phone, make sure you tell the dispatcher there has been a training accident NOT a shooting because we want a medical response NOT a law enforcement response. Anyone who is not involved please move off the range and stand near the bleachers. When the red flag on the range is up that mean the range is occupied and operational. All of the instructors for the day will be wearing a red shirt and black pants. When you are on the firing line there will be no talking to the person to the right or left of you. If you have a question, please raise your hand and an instructor will approach you. The firing line is marked at the 5-yard line. You will NEVER step off the firing line, either behind or in front of it. If an instructor sees anything unsafe we will correct you. If you continue to display unsafe behavior you will be removed from the firing line and escorted off the property. Our number one priority is the safety of everyone on the range.
