- Three magazines
- Duty-belt, holster, and ammunition carriers
- Ear and wrap-around eye protection
- Appropriate clothing
- Wide brim hat (bush cover recommended)
- 2,000 rounds of handgun ammunition and 250 rounds of 12 gauge ammunition (200 00 buck and 50 slug)  
All ammunition must be factory loaded, Re-loaded ammunition is not allowed on the range
- Weapon mounted light for handgun and shotgun, as well as a handheld flashlight.
