COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course is designed for sworn law enforcement personnel seeking to learn advanced tactics utilizing a shotgun weapon system. Basic firearms safety and skills are reviewed but the course focuses on low-light tactics, positional shooting, shooting on the move, the use of cover, accuracy, and tactical shotgun manipulation.

Required Equipment:

- Agency approved shotgun.
- Duty handgun with duty belt; Three handgun magazines, and at least 100 rounds of factory handgun ammunition
- 200 rounds of 00 buckshot and 50 rounds of slug
- Weapon mounted light or handheld flashlight
- Cleaning equipment for both weapons; Body armor
- Wrap around eye protection; Hearing protection; BDU style uniform; Knee/elbow pads are recommended (No Red Clothing)

** Factory Ammunition Only – No reloads will be allowed on the Range**
