Report Writing

Course Description

This course provides an update on preparation and proper report writing techniques. It will improve the skills needed to prepare a thorough and fluent report as the course is designed for officers and deputies assigned to a patrol assignment. Information received in this course will help to ensure personnel can prepare an articulate and factual case capable of being successfully filed and prosecuted in court.

Learning Topics

In preparation for a report, students in attendance will learn important investigative questions to ask while at the scene and during interviews. Students will also learn how to:

- Properly and fluently organize a detailed criminal report.
- Become aware of common errors, report writing pitfalls, and the techniques to avoid them.
- Prepare a report for Deputy District Attorney assessment submitted for filing in superior court.

The curriculum is directed at those who create investigative reports for documentation and criminal prosecution.
