The class focuses on the strategy, planning, scouting, tactical considerations, briefing, execution and post-warrant considerations of urban and suburban warrant service. He has attended both East Los Angeles and West Los Angeles Colleges, as well as Cal State Los Angeles and the University of California at Los Angeles extension.
