CalWORKs Child Care

California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Child Care can help families by reimbursing most or all Child Care expenses for children from birth to 13 years old when the family meets program requirements. Families may be responsible for paying a small portion of the Child Care expense, known as a co-payment.

Families may be eligible to Child Care when the parents are:

- Living in San Bernardino County
- Receiving CalWORKs benefits
- Participating in:
 - Welfare-to-Work (WTW)
 - Cal-Learn program (teen parent)
 - Employment

You can apply for Child Care with the Transitional Assistance Department (TAD) in the following ways:

- In person (see other side for office locations),
- By phone, or
- With a written request.

Child Care Provider Types

Types of Child Care providers include:

- Licensed academies, centers, and home day cares
- Before/after school programs
- Grandparents, aunts, or uncles (exempt from fingerprint requirements)
- Other relatives not listed above (fingerprinting required)

A Child Care provider:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must provide valid identification and Social Security Number
- Cannot be a member of the CalWORKs family unit
