#### **Medi-Cal Benefits**

Medi-Cal provides comprehensive health benefits, including:

- Outpatient (Ambulatory) services
- Emergency services
- Hospitalization
- · Maternity and newborn care
- Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Services, including Behavioral Health treatment
- Prescription medication
- Programs such as physical and occupational therapy and related devices
- Laboratory services
- Preventative and wellness services
- Chronic disease management
- Dental care
- Children's (Pediatric) services, including oral and vision care



#### **General Requirements**

To receive Medi-Cal benefits, eligibility requirements must be met in the following areas:

- Income
- · Residency in California

Other requirements may apply based on individual/family circumstances.



#### Who May Be Eligible?

Individuals who may be eligible for Medi-Cal include people who are:

- Children up to age 19
- Adults 19 and older
- Pregnant
- In a skilled nursing or intermediate care home
- Refugees (limited time frame)

There are special programs for individuals who:

- Have breast or cervical cancer
- Are minors in need of confidential treatment for drug and/or alcohol abuse, sexually transmitted diseases, sexual abuse, pregnancy, family planning or mental illness
- Have tuberculosis (for citizens and documented non citizens only)
- Have Medicare (for payment of the Medicare premium)
- Have had an organ transplant in the previous two years and need anti-rejection medication
