



## ATTENTION JOB SEEKERS!

The Work Experience (WEX) activity is a temporary, paid employment training within the Welfare-to-Work (WTW) program designed to assist California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) customers with:

- Enhancing job skills
- Improving work maturity skills
- Gaining new job skills
- Preparing for future employment

Customers participating in paid WEX earn the equivalent of California state minimum wage, and can meet their WTW participation requirements of 20/30/35 hours per week.

### QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifications needed to participate in WEX include:

- Minimum of nine months remaining on CalWORKs
- Possess a valid Identification (ID) card or Driver's License (DL)
- Social Security card or valid documentation of ID and employment authorization (Social Security card and ID/DL information **must** match)
- Willingness to learn
- Acceptance at an employment training site

Placement at San Bernardino County departments may also require:

- Drug testing
- Physical examination
- Background check
- Department of Justice (DOJ) clearance
- Tuberculosis (TB) test
- Immunization records
- Vaccination
