

**AGENCY NAME:** COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP OF SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

**DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:**

**Family Development Program** - provides supportive case management; operates a transitional housing program; and provides emergency assistance in the areas of motel shelter, rent, food, transportation and miscellaneous services. FDP offers discounted DMV photo ID assistance and youth programs such as backpack school supplies, summer camp and Christmas adoption. The Steps for Success program offers employment support, resources and case management. Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) - assists low-income taxpayers with free income tax preparation services, to help them access tax credits such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and the Child Tax Credit (CTC).

**Food Bank Program** – combats hunger and malnutrition by distributing food through a network of non-profit organizations and advocates for supportive policies and legislation that will eliminate hunger. Provides millions of pounds of food annually at no charge through the following programs: USDA Commodities; Salvage Food; Congregate Feeding/Soup Kitchens; Senior Choice Nutrition Program; Campus Cupboard Program, and Food Farmacy.

**EEES Program** - Energy, Education & Environmental Services provides energy education, weatherization and energy conservation assistance to eligible low-income residents, including appliance repair and replacement. Also processes applications for utility, wood and propane assistance through the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP).
