DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES: WE OFFER THE FOLLOWING SERVICES TO ADULTS (18 AND OVER), AND **WE DO NOT CHARGE ANY FEES** FOR ANY OF THESE SERVICES:

1. WE HAVE AN ADULT HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION PROGRAM REQUIRING SIGNIFICANTLY LESS CREDITS THAN IS REQUIRED BY A K-12 DISTRICT.
2. WE OFFER PREPARATION FOR THE GED AND HISET (HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA EQUIVALENCY). FOR STUDENTS WHO COMPLETE THE GED/HISET PREPARATION PROGRAM WITH US
3. WE OFFER ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL) CLASSES FOR NON-NATIVE SPEAKERS. VARIOUS LEVELS—FOR WRITING, READING, AND SPEAKING—ARE TAUGHT IN BOTH THE MORNINGS AND EVENINGS.
4. WE ALSO OFFER CITIZENSHIP AND CIVIC PARTICIPATION CLASSES THAT ENABLE STUDENTS TO IMPROVE THEIR ABILITY TO FUNCTION WITHIN THEIR COMMUNITIES.
5. WE OFFER REFRESHER COURSES FOR STUDENTS WHO WANT TO IMPROVE THEIR READING, WRITING, OR MATH SKILLS.

POINT OF ENTRY: WE OFFER ORIENTATIONS 2-3 TIMES EACH WEEK, BUT WALK-INS ARE WELCOME.
