**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 12,800 over the month and 74,400 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 4.2 percent in November 2022, up from a revised 4.0 percent in October 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in Riverside County, and 4.1 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between October 2022 and November 2022, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,691,300 to 1,704,100, an increase of 12,800 jobs. Agricultural employment increased by 700 jobs.

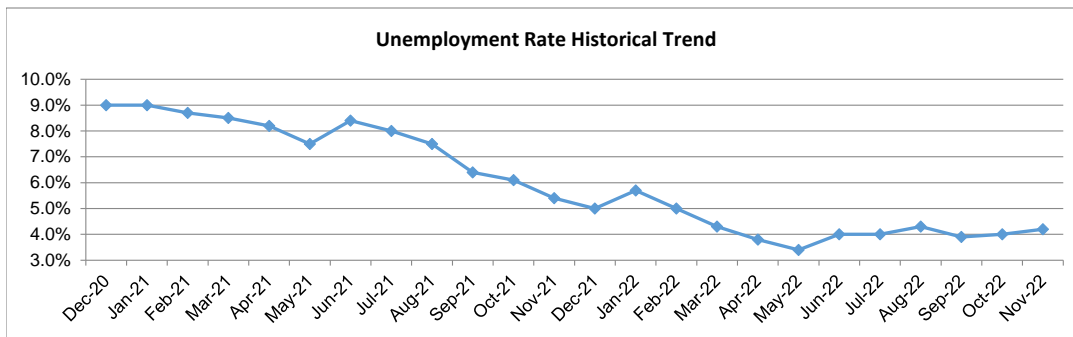
- Trade, transportation, and utilities led month-over gains adding 10,800 jobs. Most of the job expansion was in transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 6,100), where all of the gain within the subsector was in transportation and warehousing (up 6,100). Retail trade expanded by 4,400 jobs, with general merchandise stores (up 2,300) leading growth within the subsector. Wholesale trade completed the overall job gain adding 300 jobs.
- Professional and business services added 2,100 jobs, with all of the growth within administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 2,100). Within the subsector, 95 percent of the job gain was registered in administrative and support services (up 2,000), which includes employment services (up 1,100). Professional, scientific, and technical services and management of companies and enterprises remained unchanged over the month.
- Construction declined the most over the month losing 2,300 jobs. Seventy-four percent of the loss was in specialty trade contractors (down 1,700). Construction of buildings and heavy and civil engineering construction lost 300 jobs each over the month.
- Manufacturing was the only other sector to decline over the month (down 1,600). Mining and logging, information, and other services remained unchanged.

Between November 2021 and November 2022, total nonfarm employment increased by 74,400, a 4.6 percent change. Agricultural employment increased by 100 jobs or 0.7 percent.

- Almost all sectors increased over the year. Mining and logging remained unchanged. Trade, transportation, and utilities expanded the most over the year adding 19,900 jobs, registering 27 percent of the total nonfarm year over growth. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 14,800) led gains within this sector, followed by wholesale trade (up 4,100) and retail trade (up 1,000).
- Educational and health services gained 16,400 jobs. Health care and social assistance increased by 15,500 jobs, while educational services expanded by 900 jobs.
- Leisure and hospitality grew by 13,900 jobs. All of the job additions were registered in accommodation and food services (up 13,900), which includes food services and drinking places (up 12,100) and accommodation (up 1,800).
